## **January 2015**

January 2: Meteorologist *Chris Birchfield* gave an interview to the **Valley Morning Star** on climate information, the current weather pattern and the outlook for 2015.

January 5, 12, 19, and 26: Warning Coordination Meteorologist *Barry Goldsmith* and Meteorologist *Erin Billings* participated by e-mail, phone, or both, in the **Weekly Texas Drought Monitor Telecon.** 

January 13: Forecaster *Blair Scholl*, Senior Forecaster *Geoff Bogorad*, and Science and Operations Officer *Doug Butts* met with the airport director and tower manager at the **Brownsville/SPI International Airport** to discuss changes in issuance of Airport Weather Warning (AWW) for dense fog and increased coordination during changing weather conditions.

January 14: *Blair Scholl, Geoff Bogorad*, and *Doug Butts* met with the airport director and tower manager at the **Rio Grande Valley International** Airport in Harlingen to discuss a possible AWW for the airport and increased coordination during changing weather conditions.

January 20: Senior Forecaster *Mike Castillo* attended the **Cromack Elementary School Career Day in Brownsville**, where he spoke to ninety 5<sup>th</sup> grade students about careers in meteorology and the National Weather Service.

January 20 and 21: Blair Scholl and Barry Goldsmith staffed a booth at the Annual Winter Texan Expo in McAllen, an event that drew around 8,000 people from the Great Plains, Midwest, and southern Canada over two days. Several thousand visitors stopped by the NWS Brownsville/Rio Grande Valley booth to discuss Valley weather and weather back home, play Weather Jeopardy, inquire about Weather Apps and NOAA Weather Radio, and pick up brochures and promotional materials.

January 24: *Barry Goldsmith* provided a presentation and office tour to approximately 25 Cub Scouts and parents from the **Brownsville Webelos Cub Scout Troop**.

January 25: *Barry Goldsmith* and *Doug Butts* provided an office tour and visited with the new weekend meteorologist, Josh Johns, from KRGV Channel 5.

## February 2015

February 2, 9, 16, and 23: *Barry Goldsmith* and *Erin Billings* participated by e-mail, phone, or both, in the **Weekly Texas Drought Monitor Teleconference.** 

February 3: *Blair Scholl* and *Geoff Bogorad* briefed weather information to the **Rio Grande Valley Air Fiesta Airshow** planning group.

February 5: Forecaster *Maria Torres* and *Barry Goldsmith* met with the **City of Brownsville** to discuss planning for the upcoming 2015 Rio Grande Valley Weather Festival.

February 6: *Barry Goldsmith* and *Maria Torres* attended the **69<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Subtropical Agriculture and Environments Society in Weslaco**. *Barry* spoke to more than 100 attendees on the latest soil and drought conditions and the forecast for the spring 2015 growing season.

February 7: Information Technology Officer *Pablo Gonzalez*, *Doug Butts*, and *Erin Billings* provided onsite Decision Support Services (DSS) at the Los Fresnos Rodeo.

February 10: *Doug Butts* spoke about weather and NWS careers to several groups of 8<sup>th</sup> graders at Liberty Memorial Middle School in Los Fresnos.

Pablo Gonzales and WCM Barry Goldsmith met with Victor Morales, Procurement Office of the Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council (LRGVDC) 9-1-1 center to formally sign a Memorandum of Agreement authorizing NWS Brownsville/Rio Grande Valley to deploy to the 9-1-1 center for impact-based decision support services in case the office is inoperable due to a non-hurricane natural or man-made disaster at the office site.

Blair Scholl briefed weather and potential impacts to Air Fiesta Airshow and the week leading up to the event and also provided **DSS** forecast for an airfield burn.

February 12: Barry Goldsmith attended the LRGVDC Homeland Security Advisory Committee (HSAC) Monthly Meeting in Weslaco and provided a status report from NWS Brownsville/RGV on upcoming Skywarn storm spotter training classes, severe weather awareness week, Storm Ready, and Weather Festival 2015.

Blair Scholl briefed weather impacts to flying and ground crews for the week leading up to and including the Air Fiesta Airshow and also provided DSS for the airfield burn operations through 19<sup>th</sup> of February.

February 13: *Chris Birchfield* and *Barry Goldsmith* attended the R.L. Martin Elementary Career Day in Brownsville. More than 100 students, in grades 3 to 5, learned about careers in meteorology, physical science, computer science, and mathematics.

February 20: *Barry Goldsmith* was a **guest on the Rio Grande Valley Public Radio 88 FM (KMBH)** during morning programming to assist with their pledge drive and promote NWS Brownsville/Rio Grande Valley, including Weather Festival 2015. *Barry* also taped two Public Service Announcements: one for Severe Weather Awareness Week/Spring Preparedness Season and one for Weather Festival 2015.

Blair Scholl briefed weather for the VIP airshow and for the Air Fiesta Airshow weekend festivities.

February 21: *Blair Scholl, Maria Torres, Mike Castillo*, and *Erin Billings* staffed a booth at the **Air Fiesta Airshow**. More than a thousand visitors stopped by the booth to discuss weather and pick up brochures and promotional materials on their way out to the air field.

Blair Scholl briefed weather impacts to flying and ground crew for Saturday (21<sup>st</sup>) and Sunday (22<sup>nd</sup>) for the Air Fiesta Airshow.
