Less than half an inch of rain was reported by a CoCoRaHS observer W of Rio Grande City during all of June, with all of it falling on one day. Overall dry conditions and little rain led to the development of Severe (D2) drought conditions developing across the Upper Valley by the beginning of July.

While some welcome rain did fall over the area during the first half of July, it would not be enough to prevent the spread of intensifying drought conditions. By the end of the first full week of July, the area of Severe (D2) drought conditions had grown larger, as drier conditions spread further west across the Upper Valley.
