Peak rises along the river of 10 to 13 feet were noticed by weather spotters in San Ygnacio. **Willacy County** Port Mansfield 20 Funnel Cloud Funnel cloud was observed by the Harbormaster just southwest of Port Mansfield. A storm survey found evidence of winds to 75 mph **Hidalgo County** Progreso 20 2036CST 2115CST 0 Flash Flood Flash flooding in Progreso resulted in several closed roads and water entering homes in town. Willacy County Raymondville 20 2058CST 0 **Urban/Sml Stream Fld** Street flooding due to strong thunderstorms was reported by the Raymondville Police Department. TXZ255 Cameron 0800CST 2359CST 0 0 Flood Prolonged rains caused flooding of low areas near San Benito. These floodwaters entered numerous homes in the area and prompted the evacuation of the Green Valley Acres subdivision. **Cameron County** 0800CST 0900CST 0 0 Urban/Sml Stream Fld Brownsville 31 Prolonged rains produced street flooding in Brownsville. **Cameron County Brownsville** 1040CST 1110CST Flash Flood 31
